This brochure was prepared to help answer questions that often arise after the death of a family member. We hope this information will be helpful during this difficult time. We recognize the loss of a loved one brings deep sorrow and wish to express our sincere sumpathy to you. This can be a very stressful time when some, perhaps difficult, decisions need to be made. It is our hope you have family and/or friends to assist you with some of the details that need immediate attention. Remember also to take care of yourself through this time by eating and resting as best you can. Many things can be put off until you are feeling able to deal with them. If you have any questions or if we can be any help to you, please feel free to call us.

INVESTIGATIONS

The Thurston County Coroner's Office is authorized by Washington State and Thurston County laws to conduct investigations of any sudden, unexpected, unnatural, suspicious or violent death.

Our investigations often include taking pictures at the location of death, interviews, and gathering any evidence necessary. Next-of-kin may be asked personal questions about the decedent in order to provide any information helpful in determining cause and/or manner of death. Other questions are asked for information needed for the death certificate. If you do not understand why a question was asked, please feel free to ask the investigator.

Occasionally, the decedent is removed from the scene and transported to the Thurston County Coroner's Office, Further examination and investigation will continue here and the need for an autopsy will be determined. The investigator will stay in touch with the family about these procedures. A qualified forensic pathologist does all autopsies to determine cause and/or manner of death. Autopsies are performed as soon as can be arranged. During this time, the body remains secured at our facility. If you have not already done so, please notify this office regarding which funeral home you wish to use, and we will make all the necessary arrangements for transport.

DEATH CERTIFICATES

Death certificates are generated by the funeral home and are signed by either a physician or our office. The funeral home registers them with the Thurston County Health Department and the WA State Dept. of Health Vital Records. A certified copy of the death certificate is usually needed to settle the estate and can be ordered through the funeral home. Copies can also be obtained from the Thurston County Health Department or WA State Dept. of Health for up to 3 years following a death. The Thurston County Coroner's Office does not distribute death certificates.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

Personal items collected on scene or that accompany the decedent to our office are secured at our facility. These items can be picked up by next-of-kin or transported to the funeral home with the decedent and collected at their facility. It is best to call ahead and arrange a time with the investigator. Written permission from the next-of-kin is required by this office for us to release personal effects to someone other than the next-of-kin. In some cases, the investigating police department may collect part or all of the personal effects as evidence. These items will then be made available to you by the police department only after all legal proceedings have been completed.

Prescription medications collected on scene will be disposed of properly by this office.

TOXICOLOGY

If necessary, body fluids are drawn and sent to the Washington State Patrol Toxicology Lab for drug screening. Results can take several months to receive. The investigator will contact next-of-kin to disclose results once they are received. If you suspect a particular drug/substance, inform the investigator so the appropriate tests can be requested.

INFORMATION TO HAVE AVAILABLE

Funeral homes will need some information in order to complete the death certificate. This may include parent's names, birthplace, social security number, military discharge papers, date of birth, education level, occupation, marital status, spouse's name, and will/executor paperwork.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

*The decedent may have pre-paid funeral arrangements or funeral insurance.

*Unions and fraternal organizations sometimes have death benefits.

*Mortgage and credit card companies may have a life insurance plan.
