## Property Tax Revenue Increase Ordinance Resolution 21-03

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THURSTON COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT EIGHT AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the levy amount from the previous year for the District was \$3,399,763; and

WHEREAS, the population of the District is greater than 10,000 and,

WHEREAS the Board, after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that the District requires an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the District and in its best interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of the District that an increase in the regular property tax levy, is hereby authorized for the 2022 levy in the amount of \$246,421 which is an increase percentage of 8 from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
