- o IFSAC Haz-Mat Operations certification
- o IFSAC Instructor I certification or obtain within twelve (12) months of appointment
- o Incident Safety Officer or obtain within twelve (12) months of appointment
- o NWCG Wildland Firefighter 2 or obtain within twelve (12) months of appointment
- o Emergency Vehicle Incident Prevention (EVIP) or obtain within three (3) months of appointment
- o NIMS ICS 100, 200, 700 & 800
- o WA State EMT or NREMT and meet Thurston County Medic One EMT protocols within 90 days of hire.
- o Blue Card certification or obtain within twelve (12) months of appointment
