PUBLIC RELATIONS & COMMUNITY SERVICES:

- 1) On February 7th, the District responded to a residential structure fire on Lemon Road NE, which resulted in the death of its two occupants. This was the first fire fatalities in the District in over eight years. District responders worked with the Thurston County Sheriff's Office and the Thurston County Coroner in recovery of the homeowners' remains.
- 2) On February 28th, the District hosted the annual Boston Harbor Association meeting at Station 8-3. Commissioner Gleckler and Chief VanCamp attended and spoke at the meeting.

EQUIPMENT & FACILITIES:

- 1) Apparatus & Equipment:
 - a. During the month, Engine 82 (Pierce Dash) was used to stand-in for Engine 81 during its out-of-service periods due to the fact Engine 82 has the "Opticom" traffic pre-emption device installed, and the regular reserve engine, Engine 84 (Spartan), does not.
 - b. Engine 83 had a new hose bed cover installed during the month.
 - c. Engine 81, Tender 82 and Tender 84 were serviced by Olympia FD shop staff during the month. Engine 81 had several electronic systems serviced including the mobile data terminal power supply and seat-belt indicators.
 - d. Tender 81's electronic pump control was serviced after a major structure fire; it was replaced by reserve Tender 84 at Station 8-1. Tender 81 and Tender 82 also received new tires.
 - e. Engine 83's compliment of large diameter hose (5-in) was supplemented during the month with the additional hose, to bring it up the minimum standard load.
 - f. The Battalion 82 vehicle (Chevrolet Tahoe) was serviced for repairs to its 4-wheel-drive and other electronic systems; Battalion 8 (Chevrolet Tahoe) was also sent to the shop for some electronic issues.
 - g. An exterior door on Aid Unit 81 was repaired.

2) Facilities:

a. The access keypad at the Station 8-3 Annex was repaired (new batteries).

b. The District underwent significant snow control measures during the two winter storms; a crew was contracted to clean Station 8-1 and 8-3 parking lot, and safe-guards for snow "avalanches" from the roofs were managed by Lieutenant Hall. There was no significant damage of any District facilities or grounds.
